

INCUBATEMASS AND ACCELERATOR FUNDING PROGRAMS


Overview of Programs:


Incubators and accelerators are organizations that play key roles in fostering industry-wide innovation and growth. They offer a wide range of support to startups, including networking opportunities, and access to physical lab and office space. The Massachusetts Clean Energy Center (MassCEC) supports incubators and accelerators that focus on advancing cleantech ventures in the state of Massachusetts. Through the IncubateMass and Accelerator Funding Programs, MassCEC seeks to fill funding gaps and to grow the Commonwealth's cleantech innovation ecosystem.

Goals of Programs:

- Grow the clean energy innovation ecosystem
- Promote the commercialization of early-stage cleantech startups
- Fill a crucial funding gap to enable incubators and accelerators to provide the startup community with valuable and complementary resources to MassCEC
- Continue to attract early-stage cleantech startups to Massachusetts
