Hiring Process

Employers

Employers should follow these steps to complete the hiring process:

1. Create an account in the MassCEC Workforce Portal
2. Upload a job description (ensure Construction, Installation, and Maintenance marked as eligible applicants)
3. Identify candidates
4. Check candidate eligibility
5. Submit Offer Letter to MassCEC

Co-op Coordinators and Career Education Staff

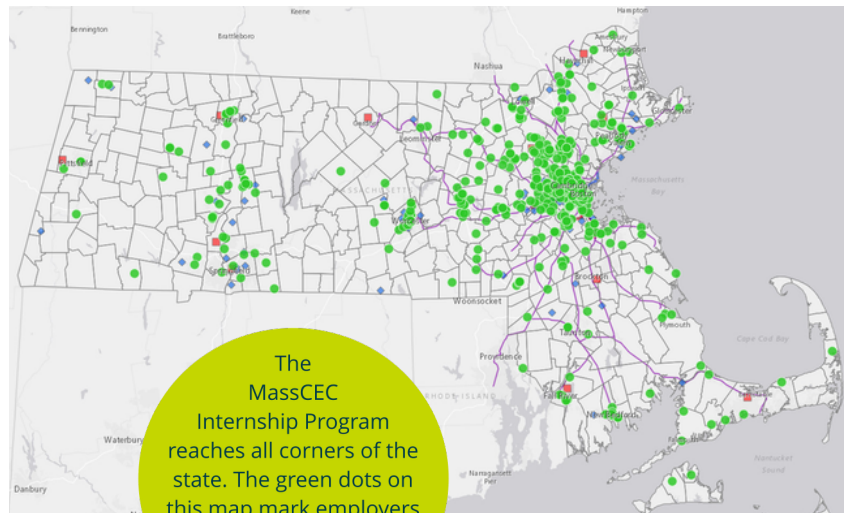
Coordinators will work with employers to recruit students by completing the following tasks:

3. Submit online application, including transcripts, for each student that receives an internship offer
4. Finalize agreements
